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Bio-soluble compliance of CSR Bradford Mineral Wool Insulation Products

Bradford Insulation operate two Glasswool and one Rockwool manufacturing plants within Australia.

Each of these plants produce mineral wool insulation products that are manufactured from fibres formed using certified non classified melt chemical compositions as per Nota Q of the European Union Directive 97/69/EC.

The compositions that are used are:

CM210 at Ingleburn, NSW and Brendale, QLD Glasswool manufacturing plants
HPC6 at Clayton, VIC Rockwool manufacturing plant.

Melt samples from each plant are taken, tested and the melt chemical composition compliance assessed according to the protocols outlined by the European Certification Board for Mineral Wool Products (EUCEB).

We can confirm that all Bradford Insulation products sold using the FBS-1 trademark have fully complied with the EUCEB requirements.

It should be noted that a small range of Rockwool product manufactured at Clayton are prepared using a non certified melt chemical composition and that these products are not marketed using the FBS-1 trademark. They are marketed and sold with an IARC class 3 rating.

All glasswool insulation products supplied to Bradford Insulation New Zealand including the Bradford Gold range are all FBS-1 compliant. The recent changes that were made to the plant technology to produce the new soft Bradford Gold Lambda insulation do not affect the melt composition and are therefore FBS-1 compliant (bio-soluble).
